The Wedgefield Community has done a great job lately about inquiring if a permit is required for their upcoming projects. Please contact the Wedgefield office or Keith Johnson with any ARC questions. We will try to make this process go as smooth as possible.

Thank you to the residents who have paid their 2018 assessments. Approximately 90% have been received. The Finance Committee and Legal Committee will pursue every avenue to collect the delinquent accounts. Anyone delinquent is incurring \$20 per month late fees. They are not eligible to attend meetings, vote, receive marina cards and stickers or obtain approval from ARC for improvements or renovations to their property. Additionally, a lien will be placed on these properties in July. Any and all legal fees incurred by the WPA for collection purposes are the responsibility of the delinquent property owner and will be included in the cost of bringing the account up to date. Attorney involvement can cost \$400 or more.

We have \$628,154 accumulated in Reserve Accounts for future expenditures necessary to maintain the Plantation.

Golf Course Update

The plan is to kill the greens beginning Monday. It takes this work two applications ten days apart to kill them. I was going to start tomorrow but they have to be actively growing for herbicide to work. The cold this morning will slow them down again. Then I will airify them, top dress them, and put sprigs if new sod on the ground on or about May 15th. 6 to 8 week grow-in process will take us to about July 1st. Irrigation repairs will take about 2 weeks to finish.

Due to events scheduled sometimes the Manor house may be closed. Look for signs for closings.

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Canal Dredging Update

We had a meeting with canal lot owners on March 6th to bring everyone up to date on the canal dredging project. We are asking for voluntary contributions of \$4000 per canal lot to go with the reserve funding the WPA has set aside for dredging per our agreement. The meeting was well received and the fundraising has been going well. As of this writing we have raised \$142,300 towards our goal of \$200,000. The existing permit expires late this year so we need to get everyone's contribution in as soon as possible. If we can reach our goal by mid-May we will be able to get this project done this winter!
