Finances: In 2024, Communications had a \$10,000 budget. In 2025, we have \$5,000 but the same mandated activities: Wedgefield Road Cleanup, Annual Easter Egg Hunt, Community Yard Sale, Annual 4th of July Golf Cart Parade, Christmas Holiday events, and "Annual Christmas Golf Cart Parade, Tree Lighting, and 'Toys for Tots' drive in early December". (These are as per the policy manual).

To date we have spent the following:

Signage: 90.36

Easter: 528.47

Yard Sale: 32.84

Total: 651.67

Our projected costs for the July 4th celebration will be \$3000. This will leave \$1348.33 for the remainder of the year. We can squeeze out the remainder of the year but there are 3 additional events I would like you to consider that we would need additional funds for:

- 1) Who is responsible for Holiday decorations? Last year it was Landscaping/grounds. With the new policies, who takes the lead and whose budget does it come out of? (\$1500)
- 2) We would like to hold a Fall event, as well as an event once the Patio is completed? (\$2000)

Next Topic: To hold outdoor events during the summer, we must treat the areas for mosquitoes. This is not currently a budgeted item because a spouse did it in the past. We have a community member who can spray June, July, and August for \$40 per Month in the Circle and Lot 5A . May I move forward with this?

For budgeting info: Is Website now part of Communication, PPE, or its own committee?

And finally, last year: I would recommend that in 2026 we split Communications into 2 separate committees: Communications and Events. Each with its own budget. This is something that has been discussed for several years. We should make the decision soon in order to compile a comprehensive budget for 2026.
