

The meeting of the recall committee took place on January 9, 2026 at 6pm in the WPA office. In attendance were Adam Hall, Adam Anderson, Miki Nadeau, PeggyPhillips, Bob McMahon, Liz Wainwright, and chairman Bob Garrison. Not in attendance were Tom Macedo and William Condon.

The sealed box with the ballots collected, dated November 19, 2025 was opened in the presence of all committee members present. All ballots were checked for eligibility and to ensure that multiple lot owners received proper credit for their votes. A list of multiple lot owners was provided by the WPA office administrator. Five ballots asserted ownership of multiple lots that were not found on the provided list. A further check with county records concluded that four of these ballots were correctly identified as multiple lot owners. The fifth ballot was found to not have multiple ownership as the second property was sold on October 13, 2025.

One hundred seventy (170) votes were acknowledged prior to the 5 ballots in question. A total of nine (9) additional ballots were added from the ballots in question, for a total of one hundred seventy nine (179) total votes cast for the recall.

According to the WPA administrator, there were five hundred forty five (545) properties eligible to vote as of November 19, 2025, the date this petition was submitted. One third of that number is 181.67, so to meet the one third requirement would require one hundred eighty two (182) votes in favor of recall. The recall committee unanimously agrees that the one third requirement has not been satisfied and there is no need for any further action on the part of the recall committee.

It was purported that there were one hundred eighty (180) ballots cast. Given the one multiple ballot that was recounted as one versus two votes, the total counts match when properly adjusted, Either way, the total fails to meet the proper criteria for further recall action.
